SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE GR- ENERGY PROGRAMME CALL

The call of the Centre for Renewable Energy Sources and Saving (CRES) for the submission of project proposals under "GR-Energy/ Programme Area: Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, Energy Security" was completed with great interest and participation by public entities. The Programme is implemented with co-financing by the Financial Mechanism of the European Economic Area (EEA) 2014-21 and resources of the Hellenic Republic's Public Investment Programme.

The Programme concerns investments related to the integration of renewable energy technologies and the improvement of the Energy Efficiency in buildings of the public and wider public sector.

Based on the proposals submitted to the Monitoring Information System, during the 4-month period of the call, the call's objectives have been exceeded with 18 Project Proposals submitted of a total budget of approximately 18 million €.

CRES as the Programme Operator will follow the evaluation procedures with full transparency in compliance with the national institutional framework and institutional framework of the EEA FM 2014-21 and as described in detail in the call's documents.

The evaluation comprises two stages:

- 1. Completeness and eligibility verification of Project Proposals based on the call's eligibility criteria.
- 2. Evaluation of Project Proposals based on the call's evaluation criteria conducted by Independent Reviewers/ Experts.

The entire evaluation process is supervised by the Executive Selection Team with the participation of representatives of the Ministry of Energy and the Environment, the Ministry of Development and Investments, the Association of Greek Regions and CRES.

The implementation of the selected Projects is expected to start in early 2021.
