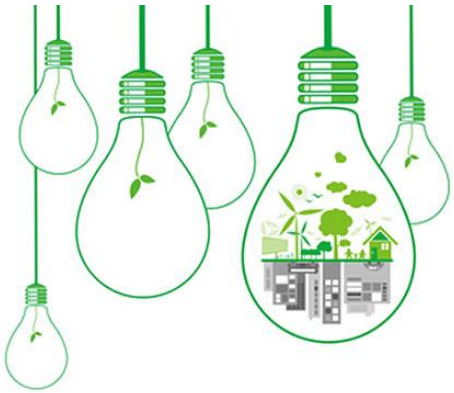

EEA Grants 2014-21 / GR Energy: Overview



↗ Programme Title: **GR – Energy**

↗ Programme Area: **Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, Energy Security**

↗ Programme Grants: EEA – EFTA countries Grants: **€7,500,000** & National Contribution: **€2,500,000**

↗ Specific Concerns in the MoU: The Programme shall support the implementation of **innovative solutions** to increase **renewable energy production and energy efficiency**, including in public social infrastructure.

↗ Our Projects:

- will result in a reduction in CO₂-emissions, reduced energy consumption overall, economic savings, a slight increase in RES production, an increase in jobs and improved capacity of promoters and other involved parties, such as civil contractors;
- will affect both the users and the visitors of the buildings / infrastructures, which are the main target groups of the Programme;
- will serve as a platform to achieve a broader impact of the Programme which is to contribute to an increased utilization of more energy efficient buildings and infrastructure in Greece.

GR – Energy: Main Goals



- ✧ The Programme's ultimate goal: creation of **high added value and prospects for the local economy**, while familiarising residents with sustainable development practices and improving their quality of life.
- ✧ Target Groups: users and visitors of buildings/ infrastructures.
- ✧ Projects: demonstrative projects aiming to increase **energy-efficient buildings and infrastructure** in Greece.
 - buildings and infrastructure of the public and wider public sector should cover educational, health, social needs etc. In addition, regarding “*innovation*”, it should be noted that eligible applicants should use and apply modern equipment in their buildings and infrastructures.

(Innovation: Implementation of a new or significantly improved product (goods or services), or a process, a new marketing method, or a new organizational method in business practices, workplace organization or an external relation. Innovation can be on enterprise level, sector level, national level or international level.)

GR – Energy: General Objectives



- ✧ Project Proposals should contribute to the **objectives of the EEA FM 2014-2021 Programme, which are the following:**
 - reduce economic and social disparities within the EEA,
 - strengthen bilateral relations between the donor and the beneficiary countries.
- ✧ The Programme contributes to the **implementation of the demonstrative Renewable Energy Sources (RES) and Energy Efficiency (EE) projects in Greece** and seeks to **alleviate social and economic inequalities and strengthen the bilateral cooperation of Member States in the field of RES and EE.**
- ✧ The Programme's Objective: *“less carbon-intensive energy and increased security of supply”* for Greece
- ✧ The Programme's main outcome : *“improved energy efficiency”*

GR- Energy: Programme Outcomes

Main Outcome: Improved Energy Efficiency

- ✧ Increased renewable energy production;
- ✧ Public entities supported to apply *innovative* green technologies, processes, solutions, products and services;
- ✧ Systems for monitoring of energy consumption implemented;
- ✧ Strengthened expert capacity for energy efficiency and renewable energy;
- ✧ Increased awareness of energy efficient technologies/solutions and renewable energy;
- ✧ Enhancement of bilateral relations for energy efficient and renewable energy technologies/solutions.

Bilateral Outcome: Enhanced collaboration between beneficiary and donor state entities involved in the Programme

- ✧ Action I: Visits to Donor Countries;
- ✧ Action II: Meeting/Workshops in each Project site;
- ✧ Action III: Final Bilateral Conference in Energy Efficiency and RES field.



GR – Energy - Modalities



- ✈ Open Call for submission of Project Proposals: launched in **22 July 2020**;
- ✈ Total Available Budget (€): €9,000,000;
- ✈ Project Grant Range: min. €500,000 to max. €1,300,000 per project.
- ✈ Project Grant Rate (%): Up to 100%, of the total eligible expenditure of the Project;
- ✈ Eligible Applicants: Eligible applicants are public entities that act towards public interest;
- ✈ Eligible Partners: Partners from Greece: public entities that act towards public interest. Partners from Donor States: as per Article 7.2.2 of the Regulation.
- ✈ Expenditure Eligibility Period: The initial and final date of eligibility of each project / action is set out in the respective project contract (Decision of Project Inclusion). The final date of eligibility shall be the **30/04/2024**.

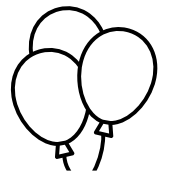

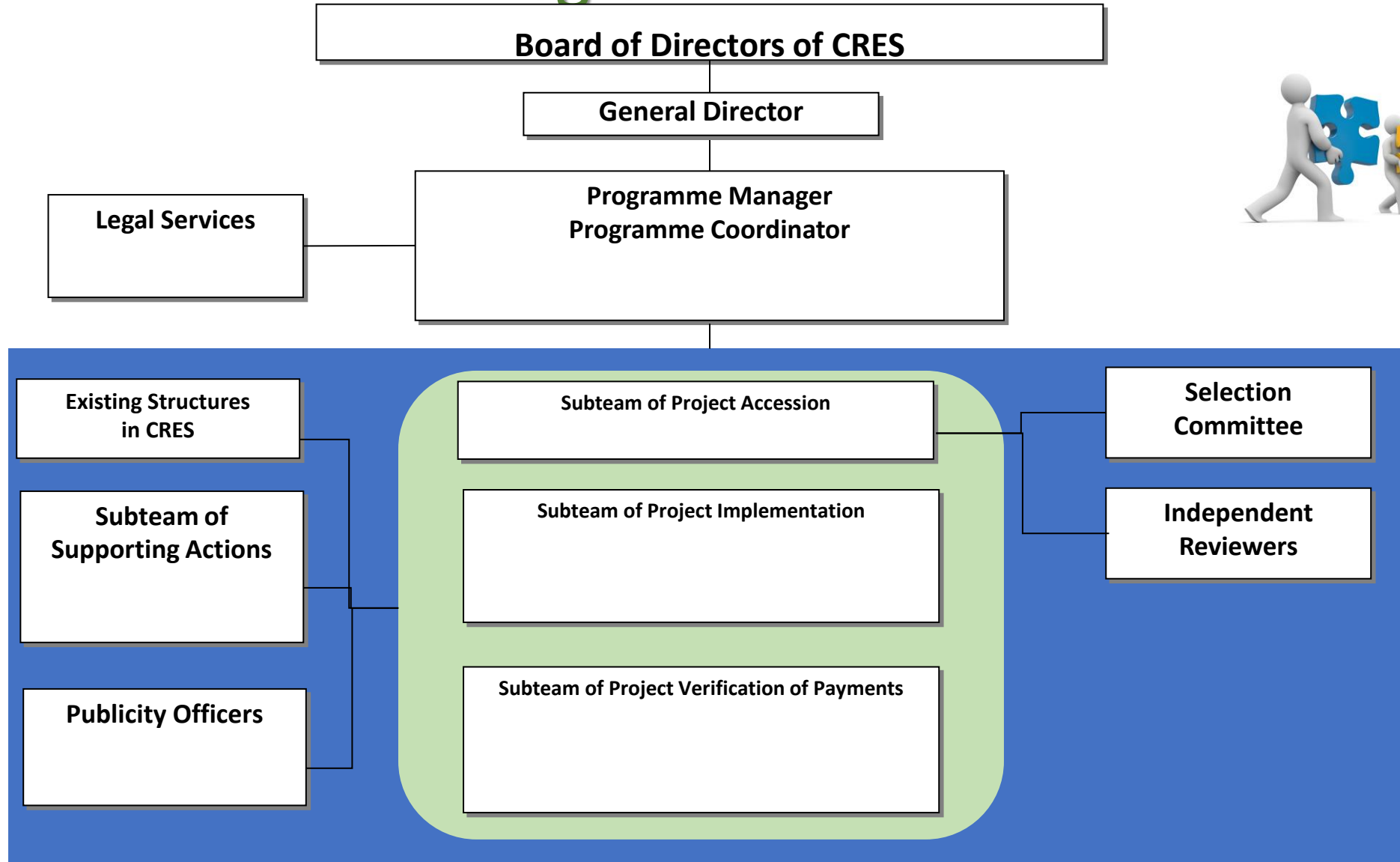
